Who has to submit a report?

If you are selected to participate in the Erasmus+ program or in a worldwide program, with your application you commit to prepare a report about your stay at the partner university. The report serves as a source of information for students who are interested in an exchange program.

When does the report have to be handed in?

The report must be submitted no later than 4 weeks after the end of your study stay (not the stay abroad). Please do not miss this deadline. You are welcome to write the report already during your study period abroad.

- Information about the host university
- Information about the study structure at the host university
- Formalities for the study visit
- Study focus/courses at the host university
- Study situation at the host university
- Support at the host university, contact persons
- Accommodation at the host university
- Information about the location
- Practical tips
- Cost of living

- Photos
